Infants and Toddlers focus: -The month of April was full of activities and celebrations for our Tamariki. Our toddlers explored range of activities indoor as well as outdoor through which they further developed their social interaction skills. They had opportunities to further enhance their imagination and creative skills through making collage, painting, and exploring playdough. They further strengthened their muscles and balancing through manipulative play, digging in the sandpit and climbing on the slides at outside. By working alongside younger children, our toddlers further developed their self-help skills. They also actively participated in activities during Easter celebration and Anzac Day.



Preschool focus: -The over 2 children have been quite busy in exploring the activities related to their interests. Children enjoyed the police visit in the Centre and built up positive relationship with our wider community. This further extended their ongoing interest in transports. Children had taken active participation in all the activities done during Easter Celebration and Anzac Day. They further developed their literacy skills through sharing their ideas during mat times, recognizing and tracing numbers and alphabets, reading books and sharing stories with each other. They further strengthened their social skills by helping toddlers and working together in group play. Some children further extended their interest in pretend play and manipulative play while others taking challenges in obstacle courses and sand play.
