Nappy Changing Policy and Procedure HS3

Rationale

Little Feet Childcare Centre strives to ensure that the nappy changing facilities is safe and hygienic for children and teachers.

Procedure:

- 1. The staff will ensure that enough nappies, baby wipes, plastic bags and hand gloves are readily available in the nappy change room.
- 2. Children will be informed that they are going for their nappy change before they are taken into the nappy change area.
- 3. Staff will encourage walking children to walk to the nappy changing area.
- 4. Staff will ensure that children's independence is fostered as appropriate.
- 5. Staff will ensure that children's dignity and right to privacy is respected.
- 6. Staff will encourage older and heavier children to climb up and down the steps.
- 7. Staff can place the changing mat on the floor to change nappies for distressed children.
- 8. Staff must wear disposable gloves when changing nappies. Disposable gloves are for single use only.
- 9. All soiled/wet nappies, gloves and wipes are to be placed in the bin provided for the nappies.
- 10. Changing mats are to be sprayed with disinfectant and then wiped down with warm water using a paper towel.
- 11. Staff must thoroughly wash their hands with hand wash.
- 12. Staff will ensure that all nappy changes are recorded in the age-appropriate nappy changing chart.
- 13. Staff must ensure that while the child is on the nappy changing table, child safety is always maintained to avoid any fall or injuries.
- 14. Permanent staff and regular relieving staff can change nappies.
- 15. Never leave a child unattended on the nappy change table.
